Submission Process

Decisions will be communicated by the end of May 2026.

When submitting to EGRIE, authors have the opportunity to be considered for the additional colloquium as well as the associated publication should they want to be. As such, authors will be able to indicate on the submission website whether they would like to apply only to EGRIE, to EGRIE but potentially be considered for the colloquium, or to the colloquium only. In the two latter cases, the paper will also be considered for the GRIR special issue.
